



## Major Project of 9 National Priority Industrial Estates outside Jawa-Bali and 18 Developing Industrial Estates








## Major Project of 31 Smelter to Process Abundant Resources of Nickel Ore, Iron Ore, Copper, Bauxite and Galena






































A new projection of construction sector growth has been made based on the National Mid-term Development Plan 2020-2024 (est. Jan. 2020) and the 2021 Government Action Plan which established recently (Sept. 2020). Basically Indonesian construction sector is expected to be back in business in the near future. Further analysis on the budget values shows the main construction segments are roads and industrial, followed by residential and power plant.
